We have temporarily suspended the requirement for new unemployment claimants to register in WorkInTexas.

New claimants will be able to complete registration once the system comes back online.

All unemployment claimants must still engage in work search activities and provide proof of these efforts if asked.

Please consider using the resources below to search for job openings and to conduct work search activities for unemployment benefits.

### Work Search Options

- Make in-person visits, complete job applications, or interview with employers who may reasonably be expected to have openings for suitable work. Job applications can be submitted in person, online, by fax, or in any other manner directed by the employer and appropriate for the type of work being sought.
- Mail a job application and/or a résumé as instructed by a public job notice.
- Create or upload a résumé to online job boards.
- Participate in work-related networking events such as job clubs or job fairs, or employment-related workshops that offer instruction in improving the job seeker's skills for obtaining employment.
- Take advantage of reemployment services and resources available at your nearest [Workforce Solutions office](#) virtually. For more details, contact your local Workforce Solutions office.
- Participate in targeted training opportunities designed to improve skills, such as completing and passing a [Metrix Learning](#) course.

### **JOB ORDER:**

*MTZ Masonry & Construction Inc (2014 Northmoor Way, Carrollton, Texas) needs 10 (ten) temporary (full-time, 40 hours per week) Construction Helpers in Dallas, Denton, Collin, Ellis, Rockwall, Hunt, Kaufman, Johnson, Parker, Wise, and Hood Counties from 10/1/22 – 6/30/23. Will offer a wage of \$19.03/hr. Overtime may be available at \$28.55/hr. 7am-4pm M-F. Construction Helpers assist masons and finishers as needed. Loading and unloading materials. Gathering and removing litter. Provide assistance in the preparation, installation, repair, or rebuilding of tile, brick, or stone surfaces. Locate and supply materials to masons for installation, following drawings or numbered sequences. Arrange or store materials, machines, tools, or equipment. May use hand or power tools or equipment or vehicles to complete these tasks. Extensive stooping and bending. Must be able to lift up to 80lbs. No education required. Three months similar work experience required. Employer provides required tools/equipment at no charge. Employer provides transportation to and from all work sites. Optional employer arranged housing available at a weekly payroll deduction for up to \$90/week. For certified periods of employment lasting 120 days or more: The employer guarantees to offer work for hours equal to at least three-fourths of the workdays in each 12-week period of the total employment period. If the worker completes 50% of the work contract period, employer will reimburse the worker for transportation and subsistence. Upon completion of the work contract or where the worker is dismissed earlier, employer will provide or pay for worker's reasonable costs of return transportation and subsistence back home or to the place the worker originally departed to work, except where the worker will not return due to subsequent employment with another employer. The amount of transportation payment or reimbursement will be equal to the most economical and reasonable common carrier for the distances involved. Daily subsistence will be provided at a rate of \$14.00 per day during travel to a maximum of \$59.00 per day with receipts. Employer will use a single workweek as its standard for computing wages. Workers will be paid weekly. Employer will make all deductions from the worker's paychecks required by law. Employer will reimburse the H-2B worker in the first workweek for all visa, visa processing, border crossing, and other related fees, including those mandated by the government, incurred by the H-2B worker (excluding passport expenses or other charges primarily for the benefit of the worker).
