2. 15 Temporary full time job positions.
3. Stone Carvers/Cutters to hand carve stone into columns, fireplaces, fountains, benches, and any other items needed. Starting October 12, 2022, to June 30, 2023. Monday to Friday, 8am to 5pm. No education needed, but we require a minimum (6) six months experience.
