Minimum requirements: at least 12 months of experience as welders and fitters, plus must pass a Welder Fabrication or Fitter test for certification. M-F 7 am – 5:30 pm with a 30-minute unpaid lunch break and Saturday 7 am to 12 pm. \$27.00/hour (wage equals or exceeds the highest of the prevailing wage or the Federal, State, or local minimum wage). OT available at \$40.50/hour. On-the-job training will be provided. Chapa Welding & Inspection Services, LLC will use a single workweek as its standard for computing wages due. Wages will be paid every week. Employer will make all deductions from the worker's paycheck required by law. If worker completes 50% of the work contract period, employer will reimburse for transportation and subsistence from the place of recruitment to the place of work. Upon completion of the work contract or where the worker is dismissed earlier, employer will reimburse for worker's reasonable costs of return transportation and subsistence back home or to the place the worker originally departed to work, except where the worker will not return due to subsequent employment with another employer. The amount of reimbursement will be equal to the most economical and reasonable common carrier for the distances involved. Daily subsistence will be provided at a rate of \$14 per day during travel to a maximum of \$59.00 per day with receipts.
