Proposed Job Order

Falls Framing LLC, 3409 W 47th Street, Sioux Falls SD, 57106 is seeking 18 temporary full-time Carpenter Helpers to work at W 24th Terrace, Higginsville, MO 64037 from 10/01/2022 to 03/01/2023 to perform lesser tasks including loading and unloading building materials, laying out lumber, siding, trusses, and other components for structure. Assist lead carpenters with basic carpentry tasks such as holding, cutting, and nailing lumber according to lead carpenter instructions. Assembling prepared components at construction site. No prior education or experience required. On-the-job training will be provided. Daily transportation to and from the worksite will be provided. \$16.65/hr. Approx. 40 hours/week, Mon-Fri, some weekends, 7am-6pm. Up to 10 hours of overtime may be available but is not guaranteed. Applicants may be offered higher than the advertised wage rate due to experience or merit. \$24.97/hr for overtime. All deductions from the worker's paycheck will be made as required by law, advances may be deducted with the employees' consent. The employer will use a single workweek as its standard for computing wages and pay bi-weekly by check. The employer will provide housing as an option to the employees. Employees who elect to live in the housing will have an additional \$175.00 deducted per bi-weekly paycheck for rent and utilities. Any payroll advances will be deducted. In the first workweek, the cost of transportation (including meals and to the extent necessary, lodging) to the place of employment will be directly reimbursed to every worker. If the worker completes 50 percent of the work contract period, the employer will reimburse the worker for transportation and subsistence from the place of recruitment to the place of work. Upon completion of the work contract or where the worker is dismissed earlier, the employer will provide or pay for worker's reasonable costs of return transportation and subsistence back home or to the place the worker originally departed to work, except where the worker will not return due to subsequent employment with another employer or where the employer has appropriately reported a worker's voluntary abandonment of employment. The amount of transportation payment or reimbursement will be equal to the most economical and reasonable common carrier for the distances involved. In the first workweek, daily subsistence for travel to the place of employment will be reimbursed at a rate of at least \$14.00/day to a maximum of \$59.00/day with receipts. Also, workers will be reimbursed in the first workweek for all visa, visa processing, border crossing and other related fees, including those mandated by the government (except passport fees). The employer will provide workers at no charge all tools, supplies, and equipment required to perform the job.
