5 Landscape Laborer positions available. Temporary, full time position from 03/01/2024 through 12/31/2024, 7:00 AM -4:00 PM, 40 hrs/week, overtime varies, Monday-Friday, some Saturdays as needed, schedule varies. The amount of transportation payment or reimbursement will be equal to the most economical and reasonable common carrier for the distances involved.

Daily subsistence will be provided at a rate of \$15.46 per day during travel to a maximum of \$59.00 per day with receipts. H2B workers will be reimbursed in the first workweek for all visa, visa processing, border crossing, & other related fees, including those mandated by the government (excluding passport fees).
