Upon completion of the work contract or where the worker is dismissed earlier, employer will provide or pay for worker's reasonable costs of return transportation and subsistence back home or to the place the worker originally departed to work, except where the worker will not return due to subsequent employment with another employer. The amount of transportation payment or reimbursement will be equal to the most economical and reasonable common carrier for the distances involved. Daily subsistence will be provided at a rate of \$15.46 per day during travel to a maximum of \$59.00 per day with receipts.

The employer does not provide housing or board during the term of employment however the employer may be able to assist in finding local housing for rent by the employee.

The workday starts and ends at the company's facility in Indian River and transportation is provided by the company to and from the day's worksites from that location but the employer does not provide any other local transportation during the term of employment.
